

Betty Rosenberg Golden Chapter Award Description

On the afternoon of August 25, 1953, the first California chapter, Alpha in Oakland, was chartered by Agnes Shipman Robertson with Betty Rosenberg as its first chapter president. Betty was also appointed to serve as the first California state president for the 1954-1956 biennium. The Betty Rosenberg Golden Chapter Award was created in her honor to recognize the outstanding California chapter during each biennium. Criteria for selection is based on applications submitted by chapter presidents including data regarding membership, prompt reporting, attendance, and chapter programs including scholarships and altruism. The award is made at the state convention at the conclusion of each biennium. Applications are due to the California state president by February 15 of the even year of the biennium.
