On Tuesday, September 8, an email survey was sent to all members in the Southwest Region from Alpha Delta Kappa Headquarters requesting information regarding the Joint Regional Conferences. The survey went to all members who had email addresses registered with Headquarters. IF ANY OF YOUR CHAPTER MEMBERS DID NOT GET THE SURVEY, PLEASE LET STATE PRESIDENT MARY ANN (adkenglehart@gmail.com) KNOW AND SEND THEIR NAMES AND EMAIL ADDRESSES. Since not all members have email, the survey is constructed so the information can be gathered at a chapter meeting to accommodate all members. The chapter president (or one other member with email) will respond for members without email. Each member is to vote only once either by their received survey through email or the chapter survey. The window for voting is September 8 -October 9.

If responding to an individual email survey, the first two questions will have a one (yes) or zero (no) as an answer:

- For example, if the member has attended one or two Joint NW/SW Regional Conference(s), then the response would be 1 (yes). Zero (no) if none attended.
- · If the member is replying to "How many sisters in your chapter attended regional conference prior to the joint conference?" then answer in the following way: Prior to the joint conferences, if any number of prior conferences were attended answer 1 (yes—one or more). If the member has not attended prior conferences, the answer would be 0 (none).

The four choices regarding the outcome for regional conferences: choose and answer '1' for the outcome desired; leave blank, the three choices you do not choose. If responding for the chapter members: collect the responses and answer the numbers for each question, for the group. The chapter response will have numbers to match the number of responses for each question. A member may choose to answer at the chapter level even though they received an individual email survey.

Each member should respond individually or with the chapter.
