President’s Liaison Report

April/May/June, 2019

1. Fourteen teachers in the Chico/Paradise fire disaster area received \$300 each from California’s Crisis Fund “Educators Helping Educators.” Donations to the fund may be sent to State Treasurer Marlene Cordova. Make checks payable to California Alpha Delta Kappa with “Educators Helping Educators in the memo line. Nomination forms for these funds is on the CA website.
2. Our State Altruistic Report Chairmen Colleen Golden and Kathy Raschka have compiled the chapter altruistic data and submitted their findings: California sisters volunteered for a total of 39,374 hours; Monetary gifts totalled \$136,481; Non-monetary gifts totalled \$122,997; Scholarships totalled \$56,779. **The Grand total was an impressive \$316,257.**
3. To nominate your chapter for the **Southwest Regional Distinguished Program Award, due August 31**, go to alphadeltakappa.org and type Distinguished Program Award in the search box. Chapters may submit one program per year. Only programs presented during the most recently completed year are eligible.
4. A venue has been chosen for the state convention April 24-26, 2020. It will be held at the **Doubletree in San Jose**. Many more details will follow. Save the date!
5. Start thinking about nominating a sister for the Excellence in Education award, which will be given at the state convention. Information on nominating will be sent later or may be found on the state website.
6. California’s The Longest Day Chairman Diana Galvan will be contacting chapter presidents with details on how to participate on our “California Cares” team. **The Longest Day is June 21, 2019.**
7. **International Convention July 17 – 20, 2019.** Register by April 15: \$300. Register by May 15: \$325; Register by June 15 \$350; On-site registration: \$375. Each chapter is allowed 2 voting delegates and one alternate. Send their names and email addresses to State President Karen Kirby at

- adk.karen.kirby@gmail.com. Mollie Acosta, CA Xi, and current International Vice President for the Southwest Region is running for International President-Elect. Delegates will vote to elect a new IVP and on proposed resolutions.
8. **California District Mini-Scholarships** are due to Scholarship Chairman Rita Prichard by October 30, 2019. This **\$500** scholarship is to promote continuing professional/and or personal development. California sisters may apply for themselves or for others, AΔK members or non-members.

PEARLS REQUIRED FORMS ARE COMING DUE:

9. The International Membership Campaign ends April 30, but chapters may initiate or reinstate members all year long. Initiations and reinstatements must be completed and **paperwork submitted by May 31 to International Headquarters to qualify for a pearl this year**. Chapter Membership Chairman is responsible.
10. **Annual Chapter Highlights Summary is due June 30** to International Headquarters to qualify for a pearl. Chapter Corresponding Secretary is responsible.
11. **Chapter Needs Assessment must be postmarked by August 31** and is sent to International Headquarters. Chapter Membership Chairman and Chapter President are responsible.
12. **C-1 Report and E-Postcards are due July 31**. See [adkcalif.org/Treasurer's Corner](http://adkcalif.org/Treasurer's%20Corner) for complete details. NOTE: The Oct. 15 deadline listed elsewhere is the IRS deadline and NOT the California AΔK deadline. Chapter treasurers are responsible. Last year we had 100% of chapters complete these on time.

14. **Valley District Conference is November 9, 2019.**
15. **Marina District Conference is January 25, 2020 in Seal Beach.**
16. **Southern District Conference is March 13, 2020.**
