

  - 🕋 The Alpha Delta Kappa Structure
  - Addresses: Websites, Headquarters, chapter, council, state, state standing, regional, and international officers' pertinent information. *It is simpler to use than looking up info online*.
    - District Conference Step Planning with dates and hosts. NOTE: Please <u>do not</u> schedule any activities on these dates as the state officers do not want to miss any council or other pertinent meetings.
      - Please take the time to **check your chapter, council, and district meeting dates**. Report changes to **both Rosena Kruley** AND **Sara Cooper** (addresses = above)
- \*3. Website Usage all members should review how to access these sites.

- \*4. These are the types of *Communications* being used during the time of Covid-19.
