Name and contact information for the key chapter member.

A full description of the proposed project including answers to the questions below.

3. What organization or individuals are the key sponsors of this project outside of Alpha Delta Kappa?
4. Does this project support a local population or a statewide population? Does it have potential to grow and serve a greater population?
5. What would be the project’s expectations from California Alpha Delta Kappa’s funding support of this project?
6. Describe how this project supports education, women, children, or a charitable effort in California.
7. What population does this project serve?
8. If this project is currently funded by Alpha Delta Kappa or any other organization, provide details.
9. How will the project sponsors provide feedback on the use of the contributions?
