Scholarship Opportunities:

Due Sept 15 AΔK Classroom Grant – apply to receive one of the seven \$400 grants per region. Applications opened July 15, 2022, and will close at 11:59 p.m. CDT on September 15, 2022. Apply at alphadeltakappa.org (Foundation>Awards, Grants & Scholarships > Classroom Grants).

Due Oct 15: Regional Mini-Scholarships are for current members actively engaged in teaching, can apply to attend non AΔK-sponsored conferences, conventions, seminars, workshops, and non-credit classes. Up to \$500 per award; maximum 3 awards (\$1,500) per region. Application opened JULY 15. Apply at AlphaDeltaKappa.org > Awards, Grants, and Scholarships > Mini Regional Scholarship Deadline is OCTOBER 15th (for activities that take place between November 15 – May 15, 2023)

Due Oct. 30: CA District Mini Scholarships: Each district within California will be allowed a total of \$500 in mini scholarships annually. The purpose of the mini-scholarship is to promote continuing professional and/or personal development of California sisters while benefiting other members and/or the community-at-large.
